

One Day Retrospective

Artists Brief



Introduction

One Day Retrospective is a series of exhibitions hosted by 'a space' arts and located at the Arches Studios. Every month, a new artist will be invited to install their work in Arch 04 and contribute to a program of activities and events.

Taking part in a One Day Retrospective provides the opportunity, time and space for an artist to reflect on their artistic career and receive feedback from new and established audiences. For visitors, the experience will provide a unique insight into the processes and development of an artist's practice.

Exhibition Requirements

1. The artist must include a wide and varied selection of all their work to date.
2. The work can be finished or unfinished.
3. The work must be exhibited in chronological order.

Proposed Schedule

Day 1 - Install the exhibition (with help from Mia Delve, Programme and Project Assistant at 'a space' arts).

Day 2 - Exhibition open to the public.

- The artist is invited to run this day however they see fit.
- In the past, post-it notes have been provided so visitors can leave comments and feedback about the works individually, or as a whole.
- Crit sessions could also be arranged to generate discussion and feedback.
- When appropriate, workshops and activities can be scheduled throughout the day.
- A drinks reception will be held at 6pm, followed by an optional artist's talk at 6:30pm.
- The exhibition will close at 8pm.

Day 3 - Take down the exhibition. (Again, with help from Mia)
